MALAYSIA'S Top 500 Largest Listed Corporations 2006/07 is a useful guidebook for investors who are interested in knowing the profiles of the top-500 listed companies on Bursa Malaysia. The book consists of five critical segments: Malaysia's economic outlook, licensed financial institutions operating in Malaysia, profiles of top performing companies in each sector, the financial ranking of main board, second board and Mesdaq-listed companies plus important details.

Although the book is priced at RM198 in Peninsular Malaysia and RM220 in Sabah and Sarawak, it may be worth the investment, as it guides investors to know the financial strength of different companies in various categories, eg, market capitalisation, revenue, profit

before tax, net profit, total assets, equity, dividends per share, earnings per share, returns on assets and returns on equity.

The book also has a list of *Syariah*-approved counters to enable investors to have better insight.
